All accepted papers, which are oral or poster presented at conference will be submitted for inclusion to IEEE Xplore Digital Library (Scopus and Web of Science indexation) subject to meeting IEEE Xplore's scope and quality requirements. Please note that "No-show" papers will be excluded from indexation. Each author may submit up to 3 papers. Submit your work at:
